## Resolution No.15 of 2018

# Regarding Energy Retrofits for Government Buildings in Ras Al Khaimah

### We, Saud bin Saqr bin Mohamed Al Qasimi, Ruler of Ras Al Khaimah

After reviewing:

- the law of Ras Al Khaimah Municipality of 1981, as amended,
- Emiri Decree No.27 of 2017 on the Establishment of the Committee on Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy, and
- in line with Ras Al Khaimah strategy of **Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy** 2040 which aims at reducing electricity and water consumption in all Government facilities.

We have resolved as follows:

### Article (1)

All Government Entities under this resolution shall reduce their electricity and water consumption by at least 20% by the year 2022 "**the Objective**".

#### Article (2)

All Government Entities shall nominate an Energy Principal who shall be responsible for coordinating and implementing the guidelines and instructions of energy efficiency management to achieve the Objective.

#### Article (3)

All Government Entities that own buildings shall conduct energy audits for their buildings and plan retrofit measures accordingly.

#### Article (4)

The Energy Efficiency and Renewables Administration of RAK Municipality is responsible for supporting Government Entities in achieving the Objective.

#### Article (5)

All Government Entities shall submit periodical progress reports on the Objective to the Energy Efficiency and Renewables Administration, who will consolidate all information and report directly to The Ruler of Ras Al Khaimah.

#### Article (6)

The Director General of Ras Al Khaimah Municipality, in coordination with the Energy Efficiency and Renewables Administration, will issue detailed implementation guidelines for this resolution.

## Article (7)

This resolution shall take effect from the date of its issuance and shall be published in the Official Gazette.
